Task 1: Using natural form objects, create your own still life to create an observational drawing from. You can add colour in either paints or pencils or just add tone.

Take photos of your still life from different angles ready to print off and add to your sketchbook.

Task 2: Research an artist who inspires you. Make notes and explain what it is that attracts you to their work. Comment on their style, techniques, the media they use, colour schemes, compositions etc.

Choose one of their images you find interesting and copy an enlarged section.

Task 3: Develop an observational drawing from your sketchbook using printing techniques. This could be achieved using materials you haven't yet used. For example, you could take a photocopy of a high quality drawing you have done and then enlarge either the whole image or an interesting section of it. You could use materials such as bubble wrap, tree bark, a ball of paper, a bath scrunchie, sponge, leaves, elastic bands wrapped around a rolling pin etc. think hard about the mark making techniques each material could make.

Task 4: Make your own mini sketchbook using a variety of materials e.g. black card, parcel paper, newspaper, wallpaper, lining paper, maps etc. You could add a spine and a snazzy cover to your sketchbook too.
