4.	In aboriginal art which is the sacred colour. The colour of the sun.	Yellow
5.	In aboriginal art which is the spirit colour, like smoke, wind and lightning.	White
6.	In aboriginal art which is for the colour of the land and for blood. 'We are all of one blood, from the land we come and to it we will all return.'	Red
