Big Norfolk Holiday Fun - Norfolk County Council:

We are delighted to share some positive news about the Big Norfolk Holiday Fun (BNHF) programme, part of the nationally-funded Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) initiative. The UK Government has confirmed funding for a further three years, allowing us to continue to offer this vital support to children and families across Norfolk (see attached letter).

The BNHF programme is free for school-aged children in receipt of means-tested Free School Meals (FSM). It provides access to enriching holiday activities alongside nutritious food, helping to support children's wellbeing and development during the Easter, summer, and winter school break.
